

Crop Harvest Reports

After all the hard work you put into your crops throughout the season, it's finally time for the payoff. You've added your plantings, recorded your treatments and nutrient samples, and added your harvest data. You can view your individual harvests on any of your crops or grow locations, but you'll also have two specific harvests reports to run, and the ability to create custom reports too.

All of these options can be found under the Reporting menu.

Harvest History Report

This report will show you all of your harvests over the past 36 months by default. You can click on any of the column headers to sort the report by that data. For example, you might click the Plant Type column to see all of your Apple harvests together, or Harvest Grade to see your A separated from B harvests.

You'll see other data on this report, including:

- A chart across the top shows you the number of harvests per day over that period as well.
- Batch and Trace numbers are also included in this report to help you with your traceability.
- Losses and loss rates for your harvests added to inventory.
- How much of the expected harvest has been recorded already.

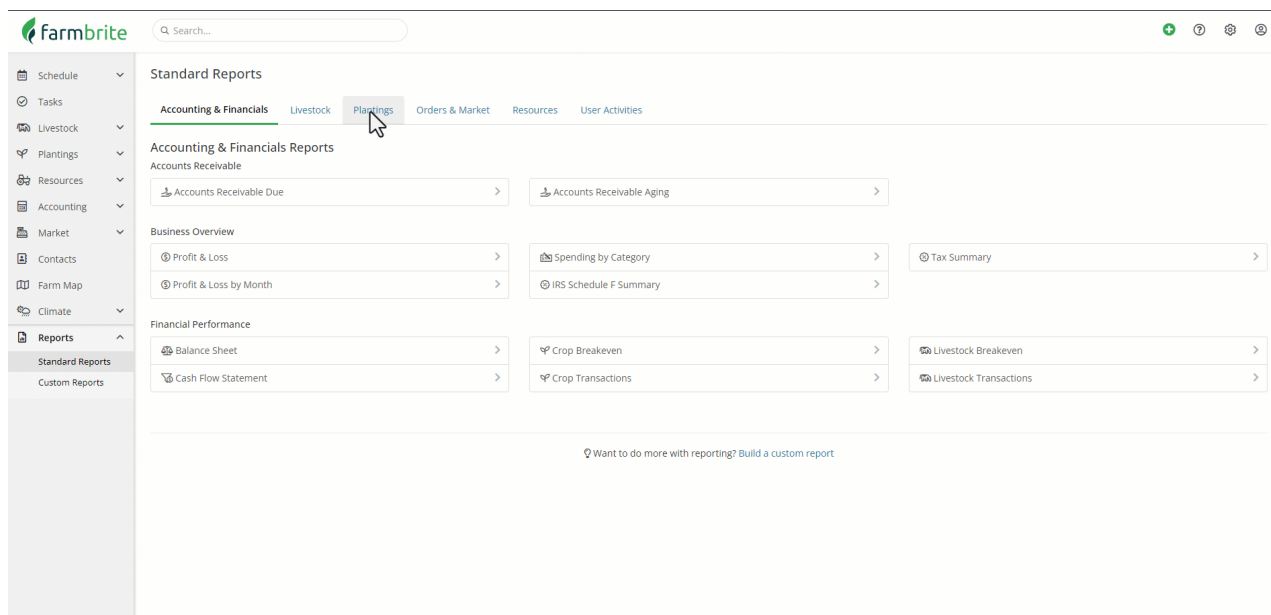
If you'd like to see only particular crops, or a different date range, you can click to Customize Report in the upper right. This allows you to add or remove any fields on the report, and then set filters to limit the number of records you see. This is effectively creating a new custom report, which you'll learn more about further in this article.

Harvest Summary by Type Report

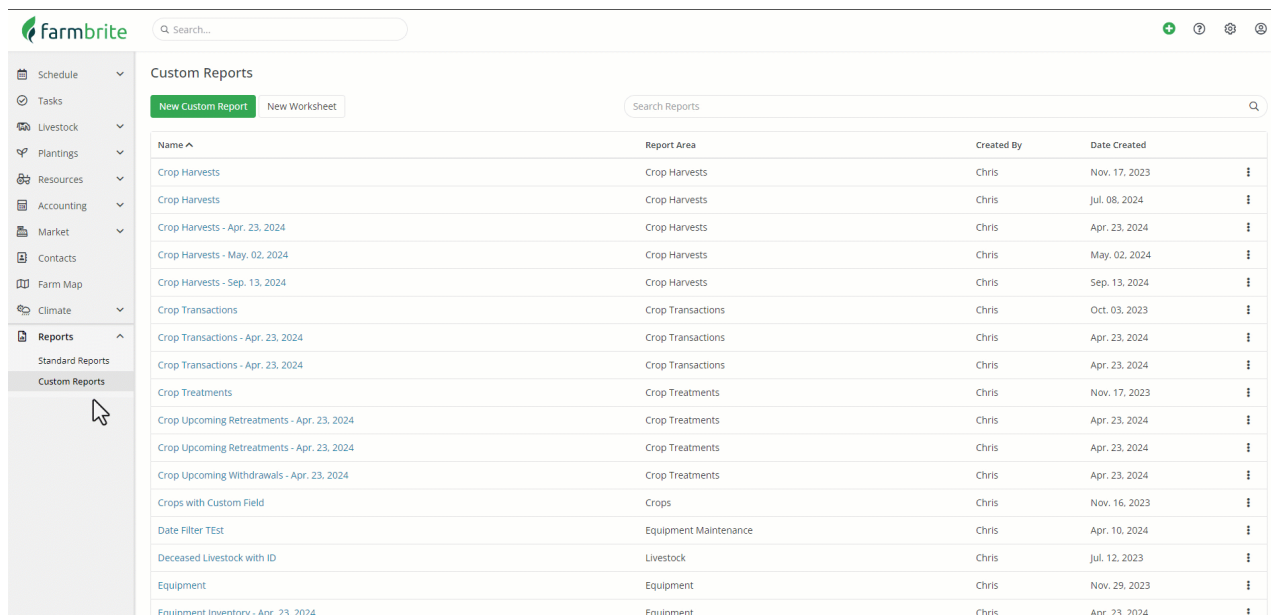
This report will break down your harvests by month, and by crop type. That means you can easily know how much of a crop you harvested in different months of the year, to compare past results and prepare for the next season. There are charts at the top which show you total amount harvested each month, with

color coded breakdowns by crop type. If you want to change the date range of this report, you'll use the date picker at the top. Note that you can download this into a spreadsheet if you'd like as well.



Custom Harvest Reports

If you need additional data, different sorts and grouping, or unique filters, you can always create a custom report as well. This is somewhat similar to customizing the Harvest History report that we saw above, but you'll start from scratch to select just the fields you want to see.
