Photos & Images

Farmbrite makes it easy to upload images and store them with your crops. Simply access the Photos tab on your crop type or planting, choose “Add Attachment” and select an image from your computer. If you are doing this from your mobile phone, you may also be able to utilize its built-in camera to take and upload a picture immediately.

Farmbrite will automatically convert the image into a thumbnail for you, and you can also view the full size image as well.

If you'd like to use one of the images you upload as the icon for your crop, you'll find that all images you upload for the crop are available in the icons selection on the Crop Type Details.

Files and Documents are stored at your account level under the Account menu > Files. They can also be attached to all types of records in Farmbrite. Including:

- Livestock
- Plantings
- Equipment
- Crop Types / Plants
- Grow Locations
